

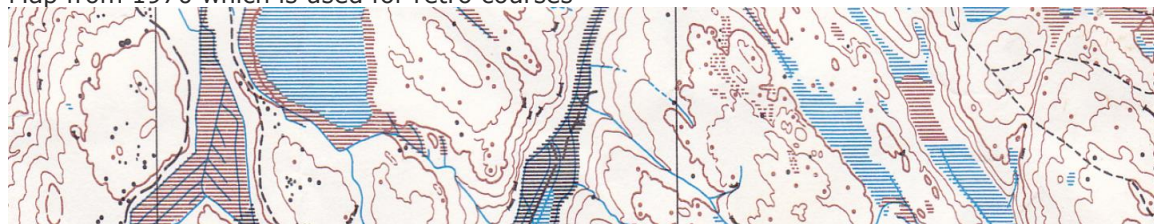

Getting there

Friday, you will find the arena at the main lawn of the university. Parking is nearby. It is just a short walk from both the parking to the arena, and from the arena to the start. NB! It may take 60 to 90 minutes to drive from Oslo city centre to Ås during peak hours on Friday. Link to directions in Eventor: [NMBU](#)

On Saturday and Sunday, the arena will be at Ski Golf Club's facilities. It is marked from county road 154 east of Ski. It usually takes 30 to 40 minutes to drive from Oslo city centre to Ski Golf Club on weekdays, but there may be a queue close to the arena, so take that into account.
